

2011 Sibley County Fair ATV Pulling Rules

Two Wheel Drive Class (STOCK)

- A----- Up to 300CC up to 800 lbs. Limit C----- 451-551CC up to 1000 lbs. limit
B----- 301-450CC up to 950 lbs. Limit D----- 551CC and up to 1100 lbs. limit

Four Wheel Drive Class (Stock)

- E----- up to 300CC up to 900 lbs. Limit G-----451 – 550CC up to 1100 lbs. Limit
F----- 301-450 CC up to 1000 lbs. Limit H----- 551 CC and up to 1200 lbs. Limit

Two Wheel Drive Class (Modified)

All Modified must have ATV, Snowmobile, or Motorcycle-based Engines NO EXCEPTIONS

- I----- All CC up to 1100 lbs. Limit J----- All CC up to 1200 lbs. Limit

Four Wheel Drive Class (Modified)

K----- All CC Outlaw Class- NO Limit on Weight

Utility Class

0-500 CC
501 CC and up

Stock

1. No engine, suspension, or gearing modifications. (Exception: Ratchet strapped suspension allowed as long as not solidly blocked) Air filter upgrades not considered modified.
2. No tires with tread bars running the full width of the tire
3. No axle extensions or wider offset rims.
4. No aftermarket exhausts.
5. Maximum tire size of 26x12 inch

Modified

1. Bored out engines, other than factory gears or sprockets, solidly blocked suspensions
2. Paddle tires (treads running full width of tire).
3. Offset wheels, axel extensions, ect.
4. Exhausts, breather kits, ect.
5. Factory engine blocks and chassis only
6. Maximum tire size is 27x12 inch

General Regulations

1. No ATV will exceed overall dimensions of 60 inches wide or 90 inches long. This will be measured at the longest and widest points, including tires, rims, racks, weights, etc.
2. Machines must have a hitch no higher than the center of the rear axle, and extending no farther rearward than 6 inches from the center of the rear axle.
3. Each weight class will include the weight of the machine plus the weight of the driver.
4. All ATV must be operated in a safe manner on and off the track. No speeding or wheelies allowed.
5. ATV must use only two driving wheels. No dual wheels allowed.
6. ATV must use only rubber tires. No chains or studs allowed.
7. ATV must have working breaks, fenders over the two rear tires, and a spring return throttle (lever or throttle).
8. All drivers must be at least 18 years of age, or have a valid driver license, if 16 - 17 years of age will need to be accompanied by parent to sign consent form in front of officials.
9. All drivers must wear a shirt, pants, shoes, protective eyewear, and a helmet during pull.
10. No alcohol allowed. Violators including drivers and pit crews will be disqualified and asked to leave the premises.
11. The first puller in each class is the "TESTPULLER". He/she has the option to re-pull in third or ~ last spot. However, he/she will be giving up their first pull in doing so. Decision to re-pull must be made before ATV leaves the track.
12. All ties must be pulled off to determine placing.
13. If the ATV goes out of bounds during the pull, you are done.
14. The puller will be giving two consecutive attempts to start the sled.
15. All pulls will start with a tight hitch. No jerking is allowed.
16. All weights to be fastened to the machine securely with ratchet strap binders. The loss of any object while hooked to the sled will be a disqualification. (no rubber tarp straps allowed)
17. The standard outdoor track shall be 200 feet long and 20 feet wide. Spectators should be kept 20 feet away from the track.
18. No same day entries.
19. No weights can extend more than 6 inches in front of and or rear of the tires, wheelie bar excluded.
20. No ATV's can be entered in more than two classes.
21. Only pump gas is permitted for use as a fuel. Neither nitrous oxide nor pressurized fuels are allowed.

22. Each participant is responsible for lost or stolen articles, injury or property damage.
23. Each participant has one pull per class, except in a tie or pull off.
24. Contest is open to 4 wheel ATV's 2 or 4 wheel drive.
25. At their discretion, any contestant may opt to advance to a higher weight or CCclass.
26. Only one driver per machine per class.
27. Driver must remain seated on seat during the pull.

28. 2 x 4 ATV can only pull in 2 x 4 classes, 4 x 4 can only pull in 4 x 4 classes.
29. The judge will settle any discrepancies in the rules and their decisions are FINAL and must be accepted in a SPORTSMAN-LIKE manner.
30. The A.H.P.A. general pulling rules will apply.
31. SIBLEY COUNTY FAIR CANNOT BE HELD LIABLE FOR ANYTHING.
32. There must be three entries to run the class.
33. Driver plus one pit pass.
