Get Livestock entries in early, entry deadline July 20th. Space will be reserved for those sending in their entries to Superintendent before deadline. After that, first come first served until pens and stalls are filled. Entry Day is the first day of the fair. Entries must be in place by 5:00 pm.

All Livestock must have an Official I.D. recognized by the Minnesota Board of Animal Health.

For safety reasons, dairy & market goats must be dehorned/disbudded. Re-growth must not exceed 1 inch. Does shown in market classes must be disbudded in accordance with market animal rules. Cut (saws) off horns are not permitted. Boer/Meat breeding does may have horns and they do not need to be capped or blunted. However, if an animal is deemed a safety concern at the discretion of the committee, additional safety measures may be required.
