For safety reasons, dairy & market goats must be de-horned/ disbudded. Re-growth must not exceed 1 inch. Does shown in market classes must be disbudded in accordance with market animal rules. Cut (saws) off horns are not permitted. Boer/Meat breeding does may have horns and they do not need to be capped or blunted. However, if an animal is deemed a safety concern at the discretion of the committee, additional safety measures may be required.

All Animals must have official ID's recognized by the Minnesota Board of Animal Health
