

MINNESOTA LIVESTOCK SANITARY REQUIREMENTS

**ALL ANIMALS WITH HEALTH CERTIFICATE
MUST SHOW THEM TO VETERINARIAN
BEFORE UNLOADING LIVESTOCK.**

Exhibitors must obey the latest rules and regulations of the Minnesota Board of Animal Health governing public exhibition of livestock and poultry in Minnesota.

All animals must be examined by the official veterinarian on the day they are admitted to the exhibition and at least once daily during the exhibition. All out-of-state animals must meet Minnesota importation requirements. No animal may enter or be at a public exhibition that is showing clinical signs of any infectious, contagious or communicable disease, including ringworm and warts.

For more information see superintendent or your local veterinarian. Dr. Sara Schwartz will be the official veterinarian of the Sibley County Agricultural Association.

Get Livestock entries in early, entry deadline July 20th. Livestock entries open until pens and stalls are filled. Space will be reserved for those sending in their entries to the Superintendent before the deadline. After that, first come, first served until pens and stalls are filled.

Entry Day is the first day of the fair all 4-H entries must be in place by 8 p.m. Open class Dairy, Beef and Sheep may arrive later but must be stalled by noon on Friday. Please inform Superintendent if arriving later so space can be reserved. In the case of only one exhibitor in a lot, first prize may be given but prize money will be paid according to merit of exhibit.

All Livestock must have an Official I.D. recognized by the Minnesota Board of Animal Health.

Beef Exhibitors: All breeds will be shown together, larger classes will be split by age.
