Scholarships will be earned; the criteria for the scholarships will be based on the efforts and performances by the girls. Please note that if you are unable to attend due to School or Family will not be penalized.

The Sibley County scholarship Program will crown as follows:

1-4 candidates we will crown Miss Sibley County and ambassadors

5 candidates, we will crown Miss Sibley County, and 1 Ambassadors.

6 or more candidates, we will crown Miss Sibley County, and 2 Ambassadors

No matter the number of candidates we will crown Miss Congeniality. Candidates will vote prior to coronation. She is asked to attend all events

1. Young ladies within Sibley County are welcome to run for the Miss Sibley County Scholarship Program. She must have lived in Sibley County when she graduated from high school and have not reached her 21st birthday before July 1st, 2021
2. She must be single; no current or previous marriages not have had a marriage annulled.
3. The candidate may not be pregnant nor have children
4. Upon accepting a title, if chosen, she agrees that she will not become pregnant during her reign.
5. Judging is based on all of the following, but not necessarily in the following order:
 - a. **ACCEPTANCE OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** The candidate will be asked to verify willingness to attend 2/3rds of the events in the year, raise money during fundraisers to help promote and support the program. The events listed are a sample of what the Sibley County Royalty has attended in the past. It is not limited to or guaranteed these events we will attend.
 - b. **APPEARANCE:** The candidate's outward appearance has no bearing on the selection process. It IS expected, however, that the candidate's actions throughout the weekend be professional and characteristic of how she would represent Sibley County.
 - c. **COMMUNITY SKILLS:** County spirit and pride are definite considerations in the judging process.
 - d. **PERSONALITY:** The personality of the candidate should reflect sound qualities of mind and character. The candidate's actions, personality, character and overall personality will be assessed in the consideration of the new Sibley County Royalty court. Professionalism, kindness and wholesomeness are characteristics among the judging criteria. She should project friendliness with proper restraint. She must be able to handle herself with confidence and decorum in any situation.
 - e. **POISE:** Poise is determined by the manner in which the candidate conducts herself with others her age and the general public. She should be pleasant and friendly.
 - f. **AUTHENTICITY:** Authenticity is when the candidate is true to her own personality, spirit, or character. The candidate should be genuine and sincere in her attitude and how she carries herself.

6. The Sibley County Royalty Court is not required to postpone educational pursuits during their year long reign.
7. The Judges' decisions are final. The judging scores are not available for distribution
8. If a candidate does not receive the Miss Sibley County title she may participate in the Sibley County Royalty Scholarship program again.
9. The candidate should be in good health.
10. The candidate will be required to complete and return the Emergency Medical Treatment Form. This must be completed and submitted by date of Judging in order for the candidate to participate. All information will be kept strictly confidential and will be used in an emergency situation only.
11. The candidate must have a Business to sponsor them. The sponsorship check of \$100 can be made out to the Sibley County Royalty Scholarship program. When asking for sponsorship, please let them know if you are crowned, they will also be asked to contribute to the cost of your dress, in the amount of their choice. A wallet size color photo of the candidate must be sent (Or emailed to sibleycountyroyalty@gmail.com) with the application and Sponsorship check. The Sibley County Royalty Scholarship Program (SCRSP) must receive the completed registration form no later than July 1st, 2021
